Meeting starts (10:00 AM) **We observe Robert's Rules of Order** Welcome to the Annual Deer Creek Ranch Parks and Lakes Association (DCRPLA) meeting of 2022! The board meets the third Wednesday of every month, at 7pm, in accordance with bylaws (available on our website) to handle ongoing business. Every meeting is open to members, but this annual meeting is usually the most attended, followed by the semi-annual meeting held at 10am the second Saturday in January.

To-date, 2021 federal tax filings (1120-H) are complete, and property taxes have been paid. A modern playground boarder was installed and filled with mulch. The bridge resurfacing project was completed with the railing being completed throughout 2022. Three full truckloads of fine grain sand were delivered and spread among the beach and volleyball court. Holiday Lights were hung at the Longhorn Skyway entrance and will continue to be a staple in the community during the holiday season. Towards the end of 2021, crushed granite was added to our beautiful walking trail and maintenance was completed on our parking lot.

Two events have been held so far this year - Park Beautification Day, and the Easter Egg Hunt. Turnout was high and we will continue to host events for the community. The next intended event is a 4th of July celebration set to start at 6pm on July 2nd.

Special thanks to all members and sponsors who have volunteered their time & energy to help maintain the park and host events. We rely 100% on volunteers to donate time and resources to operate the association and always encourage community participation.

Our primary goal for this meeting is to identify the highest priority projects for membership between now and the next annual meeting so that we can be sure we meet our 90% expenditure threshold for the year.

The association is made up entirely of resident volunteers and is a not-for-profit organization that must reinvest 90% of its annual program revenue back into the park. As a result of tireless work over the last few years, the association has dramatically reduced ongoing expenses, increased membership, and completed a substantial number of maintenance projects that have improved amenities for members. As a result, the association is in good shape for the foreseeable future.
